Pursuant to the changes to the State of California’s Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act, commonly known as “Proposition 65” or “Prop 65”, we are publishing this notice. Manufacturers who ship product in to California are required to determine what chemicals that appear on the “Prop 65” list are in their products. Below are the chemicals that appear in our products and that appear on the list. These chemicals are in levels below any that would be considered unhealthy during normal activities. Some of these chemicals are present as impurities in trace amounts in some of the materials we purchase. Also, these chemicals have no real way to leach out after the products are made. Even though we believe our usage is well below any published Safe Harbor Levels, out of an abundance of caution and to make sure we follow the letter of law we will be labelling all full rolls of relevant products manufactured after August 30, 2018 with a label and information in compliance with the Act. Labels will be on every roll we manufacture for products that require it, regardless of where we ship them. Top Notch FR never required labels and as of November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2018 Top Notch, Top Notch 7 & Top Notch 9 do not require labels as they do not contain any chemicals on the Prop 65 list. Any rolls manufactured on or before August 30, 2018 will not be labelled.

It will be our distributors and resellers responsibility to label any yardage that is taken from a full roll and resold without the original label.
